

## CASA LOMA COLLEGE: STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW DISCLOSURES

The Student Right to Know (SRTK) Act, passed by Congress in 1990, requires all institutions eligible for Title IV funding to disclose graduation rates of degree- or certificate-seeking students to all students and prospective students. The population against which graduation rates are calculated includes only full-time, first-time in any college, undergraduate students who enroll at Casa Loma College between August 1st and October 31st and who graduate within 150% of the normal time to completion, or 3 years. Students included in graduation rates do not represent all of the students at an institution

While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

All graduation rates are based upon 3 years of attendance for associate's programs, which equates to 150% of the normal completion time of our longest program.

We have elected not to report transfer-out rates because our College's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.

Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the U.S. Armed Forces, on official church missions, or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled. These charts also do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew.
